


# LAKE VIEW SANATORIUM TIMELINE

- **2017** — New city water tower replaces 1938 tower
- **2016** — Fountain on great lawn is restored
- **2015** — Nurses' Dormitory is demolished except for veranda
- **2005** — Lake View Hill becomes a county park
- **1993** — Lake View listed in the National Register of Historic Places for history and architecture
- **1991** — Lake View Woods receives further protection as 22.5 acres are designated a conservancy
- **1966** — Sanatorium closed and property transferred to Dane County Department of Human Services
- **1958** — Fourth floor of sanatorium converted to general hospital, first in county
- **1953** — Only 95 of 140 beds occupied as admissions gradually decline
- **1938** — Water tower is built on property
- **1934** — Nurses' Dormitory opens, raising bed capacity in sanatorium from 105 to 140
- **1930** — Power house constructed
- **1930** — Lake View Sanatorium opens in June 1930
- **1929** — Purchased by Dane County for a tuberculosis sanatorium. Selected because of its location on a hill overlooking Lake Mendota.
